Investing in Stockport - Improving Stockport's Highways: Carriageway Resurfacing – Bramhall Lane South (part), Bramhall – At the Junction of Fir Road and Ramsdale Road

Stockport Council is undertaking a programme of repairs across the borough as part of our 'Investing in Stockport' initiative. One of the key themes of the initiative is investing in Stockport's economic growth and regeneration to create more opportunities for local residents.

As part of this work Stockport Council has committed to invest funding to improve roads and footpaths across the borough. This funding will be used to carry out a range of highway work from patching to resurfacing in targeted areas that are intended to provide a long-term solution to the deterioration of Stockport's highway network. Within the programme, Stockport Council will be carrying out carriageway resurfacing works on a section of Bramhall Lane South at the junctions of Fir Road and Ramsdale Road. This work will be carried out by our Alliance Partner J. Hopkins Ltd.

The work on Bramhall Lane South is scheduled to commence on the 11th October 2021 taking up to two days to complete and will be carried out between the hours of 9:30am and 2:30pm, weather permitting and subject to the necessary approvals.

Unfortunately, to carry out this work it will be necessary to manage traffic flows on Bramhall Lane South by utilising temporary traffic signals. A temporary prohibition of traffic order (road closure notices) will be in use on Fir Road and Ramsdale Road at their junctions with Bramhall Lane South, this is to minimise disruption and to allow safe working operations to take place.

The local diversions will be in place for traffic affected by the closure of both Ramsdale Road and Fir Road at their junctions with Bramhall Lane South.

Access to properties in the working area will be maintained where possible however may be restricted for certain periods as the work progresses. To assist us please do not park on the road in the limits of the proposed work during the times stated above.

If the works fall on your refuse and recycling collection days then please ensure your containers are ready for collection by 07.00 hours.

Information boards will be erected on site advising road users of the planned work.
